- Caledonia Elementary & Emmons Lake Elementary will be housed at Caledonia Elementary (Due to summer construction)
- Afternoon YMCA Day Camp available by way of CCS transportation at Emmons Lake Elemenary School (If financial assistance is needed, please contact your child's school)



- Program runs from June 10 thru July 25
- Only YMCA summer camp programming is available the week of July 4 (No district transportation that week)



- Free summer academic support for **eligible** Caledonia students
- Caledonia staff providing interventions/academic support
- Utilization of federal funds to cover the costs of these summer learning programs
- Transportation will be provided to district residents
- A light snack will be provided; other snacks are welcomed as necessary

## IDENTIFICATION PROCESS



Building teams will review data to make determinations on who may be invited to each session. Letters will be sent out to those students who are eligible. Eligible families can opt-in and register their student for their session. Students with a demonstrated need will have registration priority.
