Dear Student Athlete and Parents:

The Michigan High School Athletic Association requires all students who participate in Middle or High School Athletics to have a physical on file before they participate in sports at any level. To meet MHSAA requirements for the 2017-2018 school year, the physical exam must be administered **on or after April 15, 2017** and **before an athlete tries out for a sport**.

Our team doctor, Dr. Patrick Zietz and staff from West Michigan Orthopedics will administer physical examinations to all interested student athletes who are currently in grades six through eleven and plan to participate in sports next school year. The cost of the physical will be \$20.00

The physical examinations will be administered in the **High School Boys and Girls Locker Rooms on Wednesday, May 31, 2017 from 6:00 to 8:00 p.m.**

Physical cards can be picked up at either Middle School as well as the High School's Main and Athletic office. **The physical card should be filled out completely on both sides, signed by a parent or guardian, the athlete, and indicate NEXT YEAR'S grade.**
