RECOMMENDATION

Based on the recommendations of a community-based survey, the Board of Education voted unanimously to place a bond issue on the ballot.

\$41 million with **NO MILLAGE RATE INCREASE**, accomplished by extending the current bond payment schedule

1. A NEW 9TH GRADE PLUS H.S. FACILITY

TO SUPPORT DISTRICT GROWTH

- 9th Grade Core Classrooms
- 9th-12th Grade Elective Classrooms
- 600 Student Initial Capacity; Expandable to 1,250 Students

2. SAFETY AND SECURITY
