Caledonia Community Schools strives for excellence in all areas and we want to hear from our students!

From February 26th to March 8th, students within our district will have the opportunity to take a survey to help us better understand their perceptions of school. These surveys are designed to provide a holistic picture of the student experience beyond test scores. Topics covered in the surveys include the perceptions of students' engagement, belonging, and learning experiences. Survey data will be used by school administrators to help guide district improvement planning for both instructional and support services. Students are our first priority and we believe that by listening to them we can make their educational experience even better.

Students will be asked to complete the survey online using a computer, tablet or mobile device. The anonymous survey is designed to protect students' privacy. The survey has under 40 questions and is expected to take 10 minutes or less to complete. The surveys do not ask questions regarding drug or alcohol use, intimate relationships, political or religious affiliations, or other personal information.
