- 2. Once the item is purchased, tape a note to the unwrapped gift with the item

code (found on the sign up). You may also choose to send online orders directly to the school. Make note in the comments section when purchasing "Giving Tree: item code." Our school address is 8950 Kraft Ave SE, Caledonia MI, 49316.

3. Bring the unwrapped gift to school and drop it off under the decorated tree in the front lobby. Students may walk the unwrapped gift in from the front or bus riders and walkers may bring the unwrapped gift from the back of the building and bring it to the office in the morning before heading to class. Or, parents are welcome to drop the unwrapped gifts off during school hours. Please drop gifts off no later thanDecember 11!
