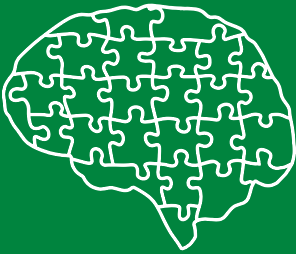

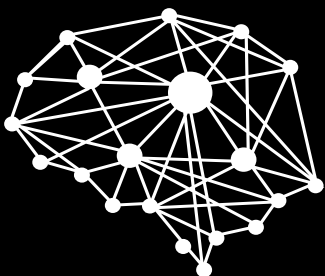
A LOOK INSIDE THE BRAIN.
