Plan and deliver content in multiple ways so all students can access learning

Assess Student Learning

 Manage and monitor student learning and plan for 'what's next for learning' including potential need for summer and supplemental learning

- Incorporates Google Suite for Education
 - Google Docs, Sheets, Slides, Drive, and other Google products
- Designed for organization and collaboration
- Allows students to access everything they need!
 - Homework
 - Assignments
 - Video chat with teacher or entire class

 - Sent via email
 - Families signed up for time / location
 - Calls to families with no email / EL families

 - Coordination with custodial team of schedule for staff to access the building





Grading

Students will be given credit for the completion of distance learning courses
