# Assurances

## Extended COVID-19 Plan

The District will...

1. Make available **approved Extended COVID-19 Learning Plan** accessible through the **transparency reporting link** located on the District's website no later than **October 1, 2020**.
2. Create and make available a **report concerning the progress made in meeting the educational goals** no later than **February 1, 2021**.

# Assurances

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The District will...

3. select a **benchmark assessment aligned to state standards**
  - **administer the approved benchmark assessment**, to all pupils in grades **K to 8 to measure proficiency in reading and mathematics within the first nine weeks of the 2020-2021 school year.**
4. If delivering pupil instruction virtually...
  - provide pupils with **equitable access to technology and the internet**
  - **expose** each pupil to the **academic standards that apply for each pupil's grade level or courses** in the same scope and sequence as the District had planned for that exposure to occur for in-person instruction.

# Assurances

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The District will...

5. in **consultation with a local health department** will develop guidelines concerning appropriate methods for delivering pupil instruction for the 2020-2021 school year that is based on local data that are based on key metrics.

Key metrics shall include **at least all of the following**:

- COVID-19 Cases or Positive COVID-19 tests
- Hospitalizations due to COVID-19
- Number of deaths resulting from COVID-19 over a 14-day period
- COVID-19 cases for each day for each 1 million individuals
- The percentage of positive COVID-19 tests over a 4-week period
- Health capacity strength
- Testing, tracing, and containment infrastructure with regard to COVID-19

# Assurances

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The District will...

6. determine, if safe, to **prioritize providing in-person instruction** to pupils in **grades K to 5** who are enrolled in the District.

# Assurances

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The District will...

7. assure that instruction will be delivered as described in this plan and re-confirmed by the District Board, to include:
  - Re-confirming how instruction will be delivered during the 2020-2021 school year **thirty days after the approval of the plan**, and **every 30 days thereafter at a meeting of the Board**, and
  - **public comment from the parents or legal guardians of the pupils enrolled** in the District during a public meeting described in PA-149.

# Assurances

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The District will...

8. ensure that **students with disabilities** will be provided with **equitable access to instruction and accommodations** in accordance with applicable state and federal laws, rules, and regulations.

# Assurances

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The District will...

9. ensure that **two (2), 2-way interactions** occur between a **pupil enrolled in the District and the pupil's teacher** or at least one (1) of the pupil's teachers during each week of the school year for at least 75% of the pupils enrolled in the District. The District will **publicly announce its weekly interaction rates** at each District Board meeting where it re-confirms how instruction is being delivered. The District will make those rates available through the transparency reporting link located on the District website each month for the 2020-2021 school year.
