








Mobility Numbers Resident Students Enrolled Elsewhere - Comparison



Resident Students Enrolled Elsewhere





Enrollment Update Outgoing Senior Class vs Incoming Kindergartners





Enrollment Update Full Time Equivalent (FTE) Gain/Loss Fall Trend



2022-2023 Adopted Budget

- Assumed flat enrollment
- Actually experienced a gain of 31 students
- This equates to just over a **quarter of a million** in student revenue beyond budget projection
- This will help with projected budget deficit for the 2022/2023 school year

Enrollment Summary



Caledonia Enrollment - Fall 2022

We are up 31 students as compared to last fall FTE numbers. Our final FTE count does include shared time students.

Contributing Factors:

- 1. The trend of larger class of Outgoing Seniors vs Smaller Incoming Kindergarten class continues
- 2. In our first year beyond covid required restrictions, we have broke a two year trend of student loss
- 3. The majority of the 31 FTE increase is due to expanding shared time programs
