Legal Consequences

MCL 722.642(3)

It is illegal for minor to purchase or attempt to purchase, possess or attempt to possess or use a vapor product or alternative nicotine product.

Violations:

- 1st Offense: Civil infraction with a fine not to exceed \$50.00. May order a health promotion & risk assessment program. May also order up to 16 hours of community service.
- 2nd Offense: Same penalties as 1st Offense with an increase of community service to 32 hours.
- 3rd Offense: Misdemeanor offense. Same penalties with an increase of community service to 48 hours.

Current Policy- consequences

1st Offense-

- Three (3) hours of detention
- Loss of dance attendance privileges (one calendar year)

2nd Offense-

- One day OSS
- Loss of all extracurricular attendance privileges (one calendar year)

3rd Offense-

- Three days OSS
- Loss of all extracurricular attendance privileges (one calendar year)

4th+ Offense(s)-

- Progressive Discipline

Restorative Practice Proposal

1st Offense-

- Three (3) hours of detention
- Loss of dance attendance privileges (one calendar year) **or** successful completion of Vape Education module
- Referral to Law Enforcement

2nd Offense-

- One day ISS
- Loss of all extracurricular attendance privileges (one calendar year)
- Referral to Law Enforcement

3rd Offense-

- 3 days OSS (one day OSS + optional 2 equivalent days of community service)
- Loss of all extracurricular attendance privileges (one calendar year)
- Referral to Law Enforcement
