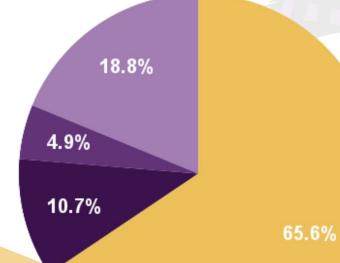

 - \$1.2 Million

 - \$0.75 Million
- Paris Ridge Playground
 - \$0.4 Million

- Band Storage

Complete the Vision Admin Priority List Considerations

- New Dutton Elementary
 - Complete original developed design for students and community
 - 60,000 square feet
 - 2 entrances (Patterson and 76th street)
 - Barrier Free playground





Complete the Vision Admin Priority List Considerations

- Stadium Renovation
 - Updated bleachers/seating and press box
 - Renovated and heated team rooms, concessions, and restrooms
 - Update track





Complete the Vision

Admin Priority List Considerations

- Calplex
 - Complete Phase II as envisioned in 2009
 - Add baseball and soccer fields
 - Improve parking





- Duncan Lake Complex
 - Duncan Lake Middle School (DLMS) Replace the 7W entrance and facade, extend Cafeteria
 - Roof replacement over sections of DLMS/Early Childhood Center





- Scotland Yard Replace Turf
 - Replace Turf at Scotland Yard
 - Replace Dugouts and Storage Buildings
 - Upgrade Bleachers





- Kettle Lake (KL) Parking
 - Improve traffic flow and exits
 - Create additional parking
- Paris Ridge (PR) Playground
 - Replace playground surface for safety





- Band Storage
 - Securely store band equipment and instruments
- New Buses
 - Continue to upgrade bus fleet beyond what the general fund is able to support due to significant cost escalations
- Demolition of current Dutton (DE)



- Technology Items
 - Additional items include: Server/San, Network/Wireless work, Audio Visual work for Classrooms, Gymnasium, Cafeteria, Media Center

Supplemental Bond Overview Details/Opportunities

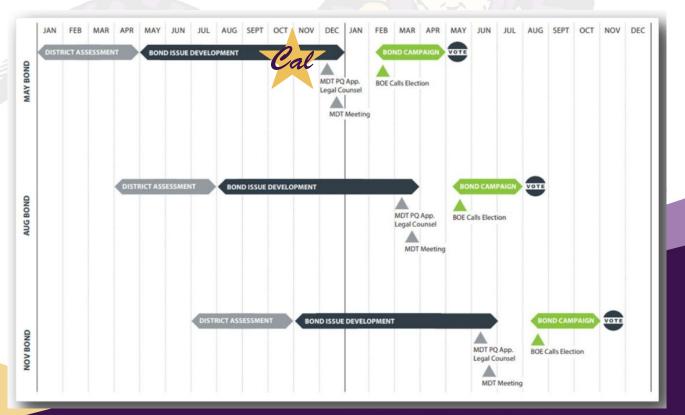
- Bond request projected at \$61 Million
- That would use approx. 49% of current bonding capacity
- Leaving \$64 Million for future bonds if needed
- Seek in-kind donation of land from township for developing Phase II at Calplex
- Seek recommitment from Caledonia Youth Sports Association (CYSA) for maintaining facility
