Dear Parents and Community Members:

We are pleased to present you with the Annual Education Report (AER), which provides key information on the 2021-22 educational progress for CALEDONIA ELEMENTARY. The AER addresses the complex reporting information required by federal and state laws. The school's report contains information about student assessment, accountability, and teacher quality. For the 2021-22 school year, schools were identified based on previous years' performance using definitions and labels as required in the Every Student Succeeds Act (ESSA). A Targeted Support and Improvement (TSI) school is one that had at least one underperforming student subgroup in 2018-19. An Additional Targeted Support (ATS) school is one that had a student subgroup performing at the same level as the lowest 5% of all schools in the state in 2017-18. A Comprehensive Support and Improvement (CSI) school is one whose performance was in the lowest 5% of all schools in the state or had a graduation rate at or below 67% in 2016-17. Some schools are not identified with any of these labels. In these cases, no label is given. **The State of Michigan has not given Caledonia Elementary School a specific designation.**

Caledonia Elementary School has implemented and will continue to implement a Multi-tiered System of Support (MTSS) model that positively impacts student achievement. Trends in student achievement and data indicate that Caledonia Elementary School should continue to work on supporting reading and math instruction across all grade levels. The Caledonia Elementary staff has worked to address reading and math instruction so there is consistency in each grade. Targeted core and intervention professional development is key to this reality as are collaborative, data-based meetings. During these data review meetings, staff members review student progress, develop targeted instructional plans to address specific needs, and review the components of quality instruction or 'best practices' associated with both subjects, reading and math. Aside from these subjects, Caledonia Elementary teachers continue to discuss and describe how to systematically engage students in academic lessons. The staff will review the School Improvement Plan and implement processes to address specific areas of deficit as indicated by data. Through these ongoing efforts, Caledonia Elementary staff will do our best to provide a high quality education for all students.

PROCESS FOR ASSIGNING PUPILS TO THE SCHOOL

Elementary School Pupil Assignment

Students are assigned to an elementary school in consideration of the following criteria:

- A. Current enrollment and capacity: Students are enrolled in elementary schools according to space available and maintaining equitable class sizes.
- B. Location: We attempt to place students in the school closest to their home residence. Our goal is to keep neighborhood children in the same schools.
- C. Siblings: We give priority to students who currently have siblings enrolled in specific schools.
- D. Parent Preference: If space is available, we attempt to place students in the school of their preference.

Middle School Pupil Assignment

A. All incoming 5th and 6th grade students will attend Kraft Meadows Middle School

B. All incoming 7th and 8th grade students will attend Duncan Lake Middle School.

High School Pupil Assignment

All students in our district attend Caledonia High School
