- **3. Onboarding new teachers** and providing ongoing support in instruction, curriculum, assessment, professional development.
- **4. More Targeted Professional Development** for all but specific to mid-year hires and supporting students learning to read.
- 5. District Team Meetings/Structure
 - a. Need horizontal and vertical time to discuss PK-12 curriculum alignment


Curriculum

what is essential for teaching and learning, so that every student has access to rigorous academic experiences

Instruction

the purposeful direction of the learning process;

incorporates skills and identified standards, one of the major teacher class activities (along with planning and management)



Professional Development

the set of tools, resources, and training sessions for educators to improve their teaching quality and effectiveness

Technology

any "tool" a teacher uses to convey the lesson or interact with students

Assessment

the wide variety of methods or tools that educators use to evaluate, measure, and document the academic readiness, learning progress, skill acquisition, or educational needs of students Positive Culture & Climate

Focus Areas

Identify all diagnostics in use and determine next steps and planning for additional gaps in diagnostics (7-12 focus area)

Define PK-12 system for universal screening and vertical articulation

Analyze data and incorporate priority standards per subject

Summative Assessments Curriculum & Program Alignment

Focus Areas

Establish plan for 7th grade PSAT launch in spring 2023

Connect instructional practices and data in a defined system across all buildings

Launch data warehousing systems, identifying reports and providing easier access for district staff looking at student data

Define practices within PLCs to make data-based decisions and inform instructional practices
