#### **Refinancing 2014 Bonds**

At its January regular meeting, the Board of Education approved a resolution to ratify the refunding of \$18.2 million for the 2014 CCS school bonds. This strategic move led to an anticipated savings of \$2.5 million (12%) for our taxpayers.

This action comes as the bonds reached their callable status after a decade, and showcases the district's commitment to proactive financial decision-making. We would like to thank the Board of Education and our Chief Financial Officer for their dedicated leadership in making this financial achievement possible.

### **Duncan Lake Early Childhood Center**




#### Caledonia High School
