




### Enrollment Projections Utilizing Kent County Birth Rates



### Enrollment Senior Class vs Kindergarten






### Enrollment Online Enrollment

- 1. Large Class of 2021 Seniors vs Smaller Incoming Kindergarten class
- 2. Full time Pre K-8th online programming offerings eliminated due to low initial enrollment (2 stu.)
- 3. Mask Mandate August 18 (ACHD), August 20 (KCHD)
