• To provide resources and support to families during and after this disruption, in particular with Mathematics and English Language Arts

- To prepare students for the subsequent school year
- To provide social-emotional supports as needed
- Extended learning support to identified students through on-site spring & summer sessions
- Opportunities for credit recovery
- Special education supports, as applicable
- Various enrichment resources for all students PreK-12 (April 2021)
- Utilizing Caledonia teachers for additional instruction during spring and summer sessions
- Providing additional resources through building and district communication (April 2021)
- Removing barriers, like transportation, that might prevent students from attending
