Goal Objective: CCS will create the teaching and learning environment that will prepare all students with

the necessary skills to successfully compete in a global economy.

- 1.) ELA All MS teachers will receive training and materials for implementation of myPerspectives curriculum.
- 2.) Math A new math curriculum will be selected and all PreK-8 teachers will receive training and materials for implementation in 2020-2021.
- 3.) Assessment System The district wide system of assessments will be updated including all core content areas, electives, and social/emotional/behavioral needs.
- 4.) MTSS A district wide process of data review will be utilized with fidelity to analyze student, building and district level data and develop goals and objects to support improvement.

Goal: Academic Options & Opportunities

Goal Objective: CCS will develop a continuum of engaging and academically rigorous programming

designed to foster creativity and critical thinking skills through cross curricular teaching methodologies, such as PBL and Design Based Thinking.

- 1.) STEM Lab will be offered to all students in grades 6-8 using Tech Trep Curriculum.
- 2.) Project Based Learning: Caledonia High School will implement the first cohort model of PBL for freshman students in the fall of 2019.
- 3.) Academic Acceleration: A committee will be formed to articulate a framework for enrichment and advancement including identifying supports currently available (CHS, MS, Elem.), providing recommendations for additional options, developing an eligibility process and parent involvement plan.

Goal Objective: CCS will have an articulated guaranteed and viable curriculum to support teaching and

learning for all.

- 1.) ELA Implementation of CKLA Curriculum Maps with corresponding pacing and assessments. (Elementary)
- 2.) ELA Initial implementation of MyPerspectives curriculum. (Middle School)
- 3.) Math Selection and adoption of a primary curriculum resource. (Elementary and Middle School)
- 4.) STEM Initial implementation of Tech Trep curriculum. (Middle School)
- 5.) Professional Learning Development of CCS Instructional Coaching Model. (All)

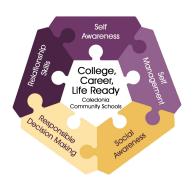

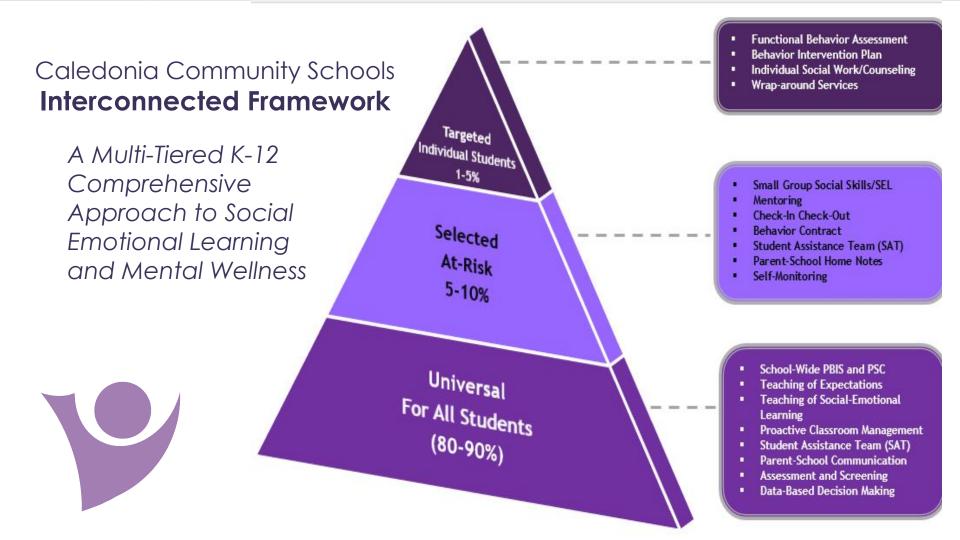

- 3.) Funding allocated for ELA Coach to support 3rd grade reading law requirements and upper elementary Special Education Teacher.
- 4.) Funding allocated to increase Student Support Team coordination and Homeless Liaison.
- 5.) Increase building level instructional supply discretionary budget.
- 6.) Funding allocated to support Dean of Students to support behavior & student activities between Middle Schools.
- 7.) Funding allocated to support Shared Time Service Coordinator to support 400+ private school students.

### **Major Initiatives 19/20:**

1.) Movement to a per pupil allocation for building discretionary budgets has begun for Fall 2019.

Elementary- \$95 per pupil (budget impact \$4,158 increase)

Middle School- \$75 per pupil (budget impact \$7,128 increase)

High School- \$60 per pupil (budget impact \$18,348 increase)

2.) Development of clearly identified outline of district vs. building responsibilities for textbooks, consumables, and discretionary curricular materials to support instruction, along with a revised tracking and accountability process.

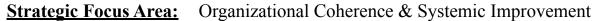
**Goal:** District/Building Communications Process
