- Elementary teams will review data to identify selected students for this program; letters will be sent to qualifying students

How?

- Caledonia staff would push in interventions/academic support during designated times of the YMCA summer programming
- Extended start/end times are available upon request between the hours of 6:00 am and 6:00 pm
- Transportation will be provided for all students if needed; no transportation for extended care or the week of July 4th
- Enrollment forms will be due by May 19, 2023

IDENTIFICATION PROCESS



Building teams will review data to make determinations on who should be invited to each session. Letters will be sent out to qualifying students who are identified. Identified families can opt-in and register their student(s) for their session. Students with a demonstrated need will have registration priority.

How?

- Identified students will receive a letter with a link to a form to fill out to confirm participation in summer programming

When?

- Deadline to register is May 5, 2023 for K-8 and June 2, for 9-12th grade
