

## EASTERN EQUINE ENCEPHALITIS (EEE)

rotect yourself and your family from mosquito bites that spread the virus:

- All it takes is one bite from an infected mosquito to get EEE
- Be aware of your risk: anyone can get sick (young children and people age 50+ are at highest risk)
- Use mosquito repellent while outdoors
- Know that peak biting hours are from dusk to dawn
- Cover-up with long sleeves and pants
- Support community-based mosquito control programs
- Vaccinate horses against EEE and West Nile virus
